## Building Project Update July 8, 2011

The precast concrete installation is completed for the main building. The installation of precast concrete for the "link" (near the courthouse loading dock) will occur in late July. Actual connection of the link to the courthouse is scheduled for this fall. The contractors are laying the brick and installing the panels on the outside of the building. The contractors will continue laying block and installing underground plumbing and underground electrical.

The demolition of the east side stair tower is completed. Currently there is demolition within the main lobby areas. This area is scheduled for a build-out of the county board room on 1<sup>st</sup> floor and Health Department offices on ground floor. Because of the large machinery this work is noisy; however, it is not expected to last long.

The east entrance and main stairwell will remain closed through October, 2011. However, the main elevator will remain open.

Tours of the building have been scheduled for county staff for July 14<sup>th</sup>. Tours for the public will be scheduled if there is interest. Contact Nancy at 715-839-5114 if you are interested in attending a tour.
