UPDATE-ARREST MADE

On Thursday, March 15th, Eau Claire Co Sheriff's Office arrested a male subject in connection with the robbery of the Holiday Gas Station. Male subject was taken into custody Thursday afternoon without incident with the assistance of Eau Claire Police Department. Sheriff's Office believes the male subject was acting alone and no other subjects are being sought at this time. After the subject was taken into custody a search warrant was conducted at the subject's residence in rural Eau Claire Co locating additional evidence linking him to the robbery.

At approximately 4:25am on Monday March 12th, the Sheriff's Office received a report an armed robbery at the Holiday Gas Station located in the Town of Union at 6123 Truax Blvd.

Responding Deputies secured the building and area with the assistance of the Eau Claire Police Department and Wisconsin State Patrol. Information so far has determined a lone male subject dressed in all black clothing, wearing a black winter ski mask, and carrying a black backpack entered the building, brandished a weapon, and fled the area to the south east on foot. An undisclosed amount of money and other items were taken during the robbery. There were no injuries reported.

No further information is available at this time, but will be provided as it becomes available and at the appropriate time of the investigation.

The Sheriff's Office is asking anyone with any information on this case to call the Sheriff's Office or the local Crime Stoppers tip line at 715-874-TIPS (8477). This would include anyone who lives in the area or was traveling near the area at the time of the robbery and saw something they believe was suspicious.
